GB CUP 2009

This issue brings to your attention the revised rules for the GB Cup 2009. You will find the General Rules, Digital File Rules and Entry Forms as separate attachments and these will also be published soon on the PAGB website. The most significant change is the addition of a

restriction on the number of Natural History images to be included in each entry. We forgot to include this in earlier issues and the 2008 GB Cup was rather top heavy with nature images making it difficult to produce a varied show for distribution on CD. The CD is in the final production stage and will be distributed to entrant clubs by the end of August. PAGB AWARDS FOR PHOTOGRAPHIC MERIT

These are proving to be increasingly popular and the Print & Slide Adjudication Days in April and November of each year fill up very rapidly. If you wish to take part you should apply as soon as possible – 12 months in advance is not unwise! If there are sufficient entrants there will probably be an AV Adjudication in 2009 whilst Awards in Digitally Projected Images will be available from the November 2009 Adjudication in Scotland.
