EFIAP LEVELS

You must be the holder of the EFIAP award before you can apply for an EFIAP Levels award and have held that distinction for at least a year. There are seven "Levels", Bronze (EFIAP/b), Silver (EFIAP/s), Gold (EFIAP/g) and Platinum (EFIAP/p), Diamond 1 (EFIAP/d1) Diamond 2 (EFIAP/d2) and Diamond 3 (EFIAP/d3and each must be obtained in sequential order shown here. That means you cannot apply for Silver unless you have achieved Bronze and so on through Gold to Diamond 3. There must also be a twelve month period between applications for different Level awards.

For <u>ALL</u> EFIAP Levels distinctions, since the date on the Applicant's EFIAP Distinction Certificate, using titles not used for AFIAP or EFIAP, you must have obtained in total at least in International salons under FIAP Patronage:-

For the EFIAP/b	200 Acceptances	with at least 50 different works	from at least 5 countries
For the EFIAP/s	300 Acceptances	with at least 100 different works	from at least 10 countries
For the EFIAP/g	500 Acceptances	with at least 150 different works	from at least 15 countries
For the EFIAP/p	700 Acceptances	with at least 250 different works	from at least 20 countries

So, having achieved Bronze, you then need a further 100 acceptances from 50 more works for Silver, to make the total of 300 from 100, and so on up the scale.


After Platinum, EFIAP Levels distinctions continue with the EFIAP Diamond Distinctions. They require the following accumulation of Awards (any awards whatsoever), that have been gained since the start of 2015 or the date of your EFIAP Platinum Certificate, whichever is the later.

EFIAP Diamond 1	50 awards with 15 different works in 5 different countries
EFIAP Diamond 2	100 awards with 30 different works in 7 different countries
EFIAP Diamond 3	200 awards with 50 different works in10 different countries



We believe that Martin is the first PAGB Club member to achieve an AV-EFIAP/bronze and, of course, he has also secured Diamond 2 status in single image photography.

To be granted this award the candidate for these EFIAP levels distinctions must:a) have been the holder of AV-EFIAP for at least one year from the date on his AV-EFIAP Certificate,

b) and since the date on the Applicant's AV-EFIAP Certificate have gained at least the following from FIAP Patronised events:-


AV-EFIAP/b	20 acceptances with 4 different works in 3 different countries
AV EFIAP/s	30 acceptances with 5 different works in 4 different countries
AV-EFIAP/g	50 acceptances with 10 different works in 5 different countries
AV-EFIAP/p	80 acceptances with 14 different works in 6 different countries

c) Submit a portfolio of AV-works (sequences)

AV-EFIAP/b	4 awarded AV works in 3 different countries and different salons
AV_EFIAP/s	5 awarded AV works in 4 different countries and different salons
AV-EFIAP/g	6 awarded AV works in 5 different countries and different salons
AV-EFIAP/p	7 awarded AV works in 6 different countries and different salons

The awarded works must be different from those submitted for any previous successful application. For this purpose a circuit is considered a single salon.

Only one AV-EFIAP Level can be applied for in any one year and they must ALL be achieved in sequence (you can't skip one even if you have the necessary criteria).


