

We have received some reports of Club members booking photographic holidays which resulted in them losing deposits when the holiday was not forthcoming.

PAGB advice is that photographers should take reasonable steps to ensure they are properly protected when booking Photography Tours or Workshops.

For instance, enquire if the tour organiser is a member of ABTA, which offers protection to consumers if the tour operator goes bust or ceases to operate.

Be sure to pay by credit card, as your credit card company is jointly liable for any default by the tour operator!

Always check references and ask around!



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Masters of Print Hall of Fame

Sharon Sawyer CPAGB




I've been taking photos since I was eight and I have owned an SLR from the age of 14. I mostly took photos of my pets and places on holiday. I went digital in 2000, with a camera that cost as much as my current one but with only 10% of the pixels.

I continued to take photos, mostly out and about in the countryside. That led me and my husband to go on a landscape photography workshop in the Lake District with John Gravett. There we learned a lot about composition and camera settings and felt better equipped to document our travels in the UK and abroad.

However, it wasn't until we joined Ilkley Camera Club in 2015 that we started getting into photography seriously. I remember a visit by Dianne Owen, in our first season at the club, and I decided to have a go at still life and creative photography. As a teenager I liked watercolour painting and I went on several summer courses doing botanical illustration, so I'm not surprised that have gravitated towards creating 'artistic' photographs of plants and flowers. We have a large garden with plenty of flowers, and a now rapidly growing collection of vases and bottles! Four out of ten images in my successful CPAGB assessment last year were flowers.

Daisies in Bottle is made up from several images. There is one main image of the daisies arranged in the glass bottle, showing the flowers in various stages of growth. Then, there are three blurred images of the daisies in the garden, blended together in the background with a couple of textured layers.
