

Closing date for online entries. Wednesday 11 January 2023. Reception of GB Trophy prints. Saturday 14 January 2023.

**NEW.** Prints which were entered to the MASTERS of PRINT 2023 may be forwarded, free of any charge, directly to the GB Trophy provided that the print has been selected and entered online by the Club and provided that the labels have been downloaded for that competition and have been forwarded to the Organiser who will fix them to the appropriate Prints.

MASTERS OF PRINT entrants are asked to inform their Club that their Prints have been entered for the MOP and are available for selection to the GB Trophy. Of course, if your print was accepted to the MASTERS exhibition, we will need another copy.

These are separate competitions and the same images can be entered to both. However, under temporary arrangements they are being judged this year at the same time and you are asked to avoid entering duplicate images if possible.

The Small Club category has been replaced in the GB Cup with a **Limited Eligibility** category\* so as to permit Clubs to compete at their chosen level, rather than enter the Open section which is often dominated by just a few Clubs. Which category they enter is entirely the choice of each Club, within the definition\*, but no single Club may enter both.

\*The Limited Eligibility Category is restricted to Clubs which have not previously won this Category (or the replaced GB Cup Small Clubs), and which have not previously been nominated to compete at either the PAGB Print Championship or the PAGB Projected Digital Image Championship.

### DON'T LET YOUR CLUB MISS OUT

It appears that I forgot to update the Central Entry System with the revised criteria for the number of entries that a Club may make. These changes have now been made.

In each of the Three GB Cup Categories, the following applies.

Minimum number of authors = 1Minimum number of images = 1

Maximum images per author = 4

Maximum images per Club

In the GB Cup Open and in the GB Cup Nature, the Top 12 scoring images will determine the Total Score.

In the GB Cup Restricted Entry, the Top 10 scoring images will determine the Total Score.

In each of the Two GB Trophy Categories, the following applies.

Minimum number of authors = 1Minimum number of prints

Maximum prints per author = 4

Maximum prints per Club

In the GB Trophy Open and in the GB Trophy Nature, the Top 12 scoring images will determine the Total Score.

Any prints which have been entered to the MASTERS OF PRINT this year may be chosen for the club entry. Print the labels and post them to the Organiser, with any new prints. We will forward the MPP prints free of charge to the GB Trophy.





#### JOHN GOULD FRPS

John Gould sadly passed away recently. He was 77. Many of you will know him for his very individual and artistic darkroom work and also as a member of the Arena Photography Group. John was originally from South Wales, but lived in Gloucester, and he worked on both the conventional and nuclear sides of the Power Generating Industry.

His photography involved portraiture with which he gained his Fellowship some 30 years ago. He produced an impressive portfolio of studio work and some delicate, muted hued tonal imagery that he made when travelling. Many will have seen his soft, lyrical Lith prints of Venice, Spain and New England.

John was not one for convention - his printing was markedly different, using a number of techniques



involving distressing the picture and, above all, toning them in an unusual way. He passed this knowledge on freely in workshops or lectures on the club circuit. John somehow managed to avoid getting too involved in the digital process, his preference was for large format film cameras.

He was a member of Cotswold Monochrome and previously Gloucester Camera Club. For those of us that knew him well, we will miss his presence in photography, his take on life and his friendship.
