### AWARDS FOR PHOTOGRAPHIC MERIT – NOVEMBER 2023 ADJUDICATION

It was another successful APM Adjudication weekend with the Print entries being assessed at The Jubilee Hotel, Nottingham on Saturday 25 November and the Projected Digital Images at Smethwick Clubrooms on Sunday 26 November.

There were 9 entrants in the first ever Badge (BPAGB) Print section and 8 were successful. 27 entrants in the Credit (CPAGB) Print section with 20 successful and in the Credit PDI, out of 25 entrants 19 were successful. In the Distinction (DPAGB) Print category there were 17 entrants with 6 successful, whilst in Distinction PDI there were 20 entrants with 8 successful. In the new Excellence (EPAGB) Print category there were 10 entrants with 5 successful and in the Master (MPAGB) Print, out of 7 entrants, 4 photographers gained the Award.

We are indebted to the North & East Midlands Photographic Federation for their hard work in organising the Print event, Carol Cheetham the Organising & Reception Secretary, N&EMPf President, Sue Wilson, Print Handlers Steve Walters, Louise & Gary Langley, Brian & Shirley Davis, Peter Jones and Dave Severn, who was also resident Photographer for both venues. The event ran very smoothly. Thank you all.
